Open Access memberships

The following criteria apply so that authors of the University of Zurich can profit from the membership conditions of the University of Zurich with BioMed Central/Springer Open and Frontiers when submitting articles to the publishers:

- (1) The first or last author is an employee of either the University of Zurich or of one of the hospitals and clinics¹ associated with the University of Zurich with the implicit understanding that the work was mainly created there.
- (2) If neither the first nor the last author is an employee of the UZH or the associated hospitals, then the submitting author as well as at least one third of all authors has to be employed at the UZH or the associated hospitals.
- (3) Privatdozierende or Titularprofessoren (adjunct professors, senior lecturers) that are employed by a separate institution can submit a publication via the membership if at least one third of all authors is employed by the UZH or by one of the associated hospitals.
- (4) An employment means a current employment or at the time when the work was created (from doctorate level).

Biomed Central / Springer Open (since 2012)

- The submitting author must indicate the institution (University of Zurich or an associated hospital) and department (according to the UZH organisation database - www.orgdb.uzh.ch) of each author during submission.

Frontiers Research Foundation (since 2015)

- During submission the University of Zurich or the University Hospital Zurich must be chosen from a drop-down list provided by the publisher.

In each case the Main Library of the University of Zurich reserves the right to accept or decline a publication submitted under the conditions of the membership independently of the guidelines listed above. In addition, alternative financing options (e.g. via SNSF <https://oa100.snf.ch/>) are being examined.
